### Route(s) of Entry:

**Steps to Be Taken in Case Material Is Released or Spilled:** Absorb material with vermiculite. Collect in drums for disposal.

**Waste Disposal Method:** Dispose of in accordance with Federal, State and Local Regulations.

**Precautions to be taken in Handling and Storing:** Keep containers closed. Store in dry environment

**Other Precautions:** Avoid breathing vapors.
